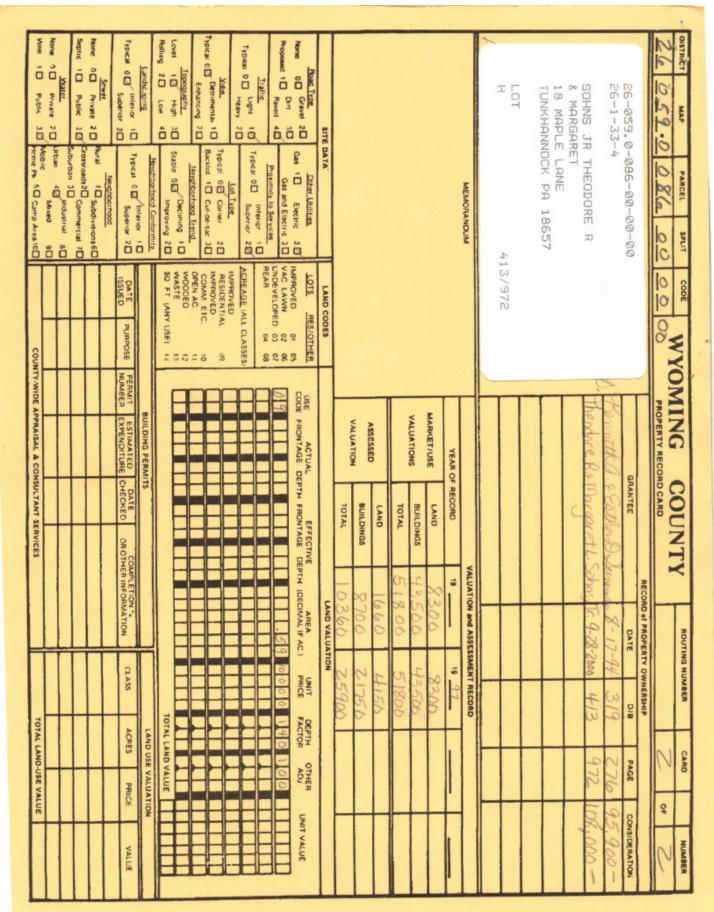

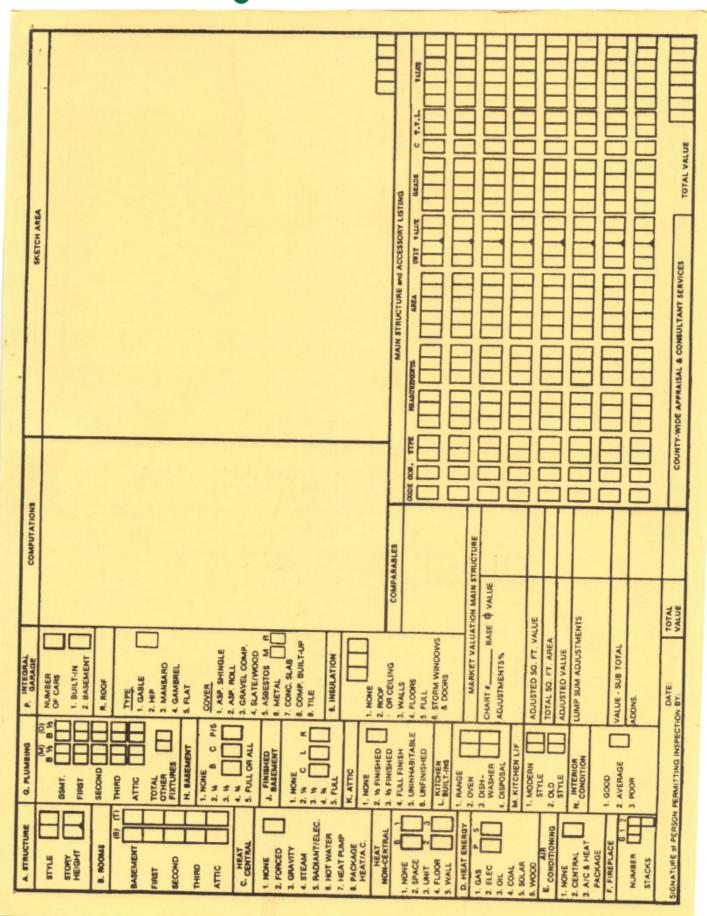

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED by and between the parties hereto and the parties do, by the delivery and acceptance of this Deed, covenant and agree that the lands hereby conveyed shall be bound by the following covenants and restrictions, which shall run with the lands:

- No use shall be made of the said lands except for residential purposes.
- No residence or dwelling shall be erected upon said lands containing less than eight hundred (800) square feet of floor space.
- No building shall be erected upon said lands within twenty-five (25) feet from the right-of-way line of any street heretofore or hereafter laid out upon, across or through any of said lands.
